Dr. McMurray established Renaissance Church of God in Christ August 22, 1992, with only his wife and their 3 children. Today the Renaissance Congregation is a progressive 21st century ministry that influences believers locally and around the world through weekly worship, television and radio ministries.

Dr. McMurray is a native of Muskegon Heights, Michigan. He earned an Associate's Degree from Muskegon Community College and a Bachelor of Business Administration Degree from Grand Valley State University. In 2014 he was conferred a Doctorate of Divinity from Christian Bible Institute and Seminary of Spring, Texas.

Ecclesiastically, Dr. McMurray serves as the Administrative Assistant to the Bishop of the Western Michigan Jurisdiction of the Church of God in Christ. In this capacity, he works directly with senior management of this 7-million-member denomination in the areas of global ministry development and organizational expansion. He facilitates seminars, a motivational speaker for corporations, educational and social institutions and develops programs for Church Growth and Community Empowerment. In 2014, Dr. McMurray was selected by Christians United for Israel (CUFI) to represent Michigan as clergy from every state of the United States traveled to Israel to stand in Solidarity during the Gaza Conflict. He was recently published in the fall 2015 Leadership Journal.
